





Public spending for healthcare (% of GDP, average 2006-2014)





Public spending for education (% of GDP, average 2006-2014)






General government expenditure structure by function (%, 2014)


Very low tax revenues – the main constraint for the budget in Romania

Tax revenues (% of GDP)





Public investments (% of GDP, average for 2006-2015)




